I am enclosing for you copies of letters to the Duke of Montrose in connection with the above matter. You will note what he says in regard to this.

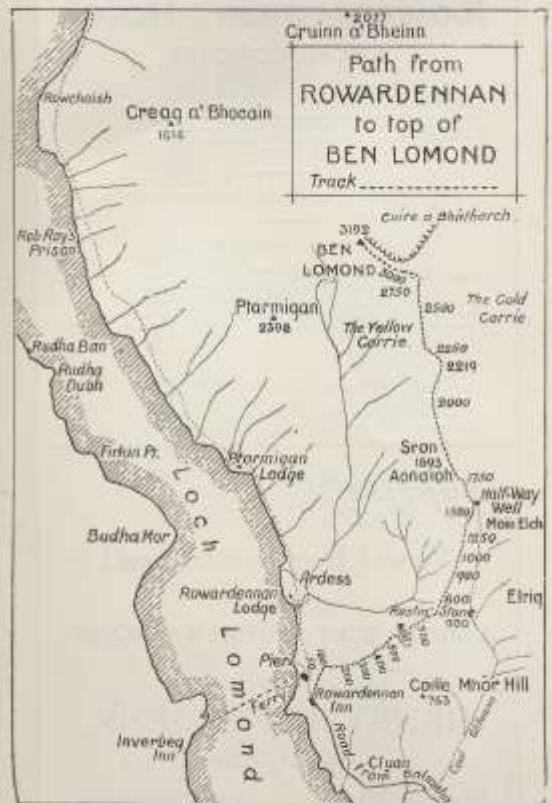

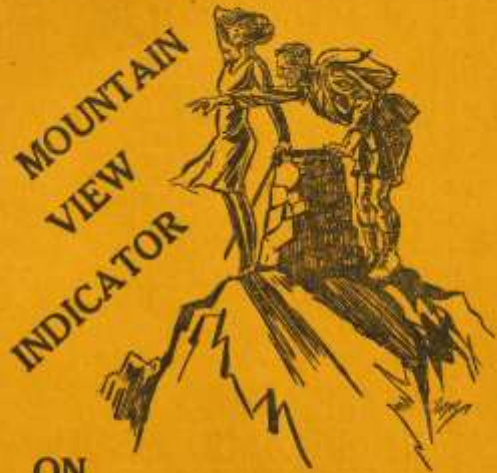
